2016-2017 Orange County Executive Arts,
Heritage and Tourism Grant

WHEREAS, the Village of Highland Falls actively pursues grant opportunities, and

WHEREAS, the 2016-17 Orange County Executive Arts, Heritage and Tourism Grant Program has been announced, and

WHEREAS, The Village of Highland Falls is desirous of supporting the arts and public displays to promote tourism related to economic development, and

WHEREAS, significant groundwork was laid during the Village's first Art Walk in 2015 that created infrastructure to support proper display of sculpture,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Highland Falls, in its capacity as governing body of the Village of Highland Falls, does hereby support and concur in the application of the 2016-17 Orange County Executive Arts, Heritage and Tourism Grant for up to \$5,000 to stage a 2017 Art Walk of approximately (12) twelve sculptures along Main Street, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village is giving priority to artwork created in Orange County, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the Village of Highland Falls is authorized to sign any paperwork necessary for the submission of this grant application due by December 1, 2016.
