

**RESOLUTION INTRODUCING LOCAL LAW
AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC
NOTICE AND HEARING**

BE IT RESOLVED that an introductory Local Law entitled “Standards for Lodging Houses and Single-Family and Two-Family Dwellings with Lodgers,” be and it hereby is introduced by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Highland Falls in the County of Orange and State of New York, and;

A complete copy of the Introductory Local Law is available for inspection at the Clerk’s Office, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of the aforesaid proposed local law be laid upon the desk of each member of the Board, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hold a public hearing on said proposed local law at the Village Hall, 303 Main Street, in the Village of Highland Falls, New York at 7:00PM on August 1, 2011, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk publish or cause to be published a public notice in the official newspaper of the Village of Highland Falls of said public hearing at least five (5) days prior thereto.

On a motion by Trustee McCormick, seconded by Trustee DiSalvo, the resolution was adopted on a roll call vote, the results which follow:
