SEQR Declaration**

WHEREAS, the Village of Highland Falls is considering making application to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation (NYSEFC) Drinking Water Program for the installation of a raw water transmission main from the reservoirs, and

WHEREAS, the Village has cause to have prepared a Full Environmental Assessment Form under the State Environmental Quality Review Act, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has assumed Lead Agency status, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has taken and determined that the application process is to be ministerial and a Type II Action,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Highland Falls determined, based on the information and analysis in the Long Form EAF and supporting documentation, that the proposed action will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts and further authorizes the Mayor to sign the SEQR documents accordingly.
