

VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND FALLS
INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW
AMENDMENT TO DOGS PROHIBITED IN PUBLIC PARKS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Highland Falls, County of Orange, State of New York, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 53, titled “Animals”, of the Code of the Village of Highland Falls, section 53-5.1 titled “Dogs prohibited in certain public parks,” is amended to insert “Center Street Park,” before Ladycliff Park to read as follows:

§53-5.1 All dogs, whether on a or off leash, shall be prohibited inCenter Street Park, Ladycliff Park and Memorial Park. The presence of any dog in Center Street Park, Ladycliff Park and Memorial Park shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of the provisions of this section and the owner of such dog shall be subject to the penalty provisions of this chapter. This section shall not apply to service dog accompanying a handicapped person.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
