Subject: LARVICIDING MUNICIPALITY OWNED CATCH BASINS

The Orange County Department of Health has contracted with Alleymor, Inc. d/b/a Pestmaster Services to provide larvicide application to municipality owned catch basins. The larvicide to be used will be Altosid (methoprene) briquettes. This will prevent mosquito breeding in the catch basins.

Pestmaster Services expects to start larviciding in your town, village or city according to the schedule below. They will be in vehicles identified as belonging to Pestmaster Services and workers will be carrying identification.

Mosquito experts from Orange County Community College (SUNY Orange) will continue to trap throughout Orange County until October, 2017. They will also carry identification.

September 4 – September 29:	Chester, Blooming Grove, Florida, Middlehope, Otisville, Scotchtown, New Hampton, Wawayanda, Deer Park
