

SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF HIGHLAND FALLS

April 12, 2018

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Highland Falls was held in Village Hall, 303 Main Street, Highland Falls, New York on April 12, 2018.

The purpose of the meeting was to hold the fifth budget workshop for FY 2018-2019.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor D'Onofrio at 6:00P.M.

Discussion was held on the following topics:

- a. Current water rates;
- b. Municipal fee schedule;
- c. Hiring a seasonal or part time person for three months to take care of the watering of the flowers along Main Street and in the garden during the summer season. Discussion included the possibility of this person maintaining the bathrooms at the Roe Park and doing janitorial services at the Senior Center;
- d. Hiring the Public Works Supervisor position;
- e. Health insurance plans and Union Contracts regarding health insurance benefits

Mayor D'Onofrio directed the Village Treasurer to increase the Parks Salary line by \$4,000.00 and decrease the Street Administration Salary line by \$4,000.00 for a seasonal hire.

Village Treasurer Walters commented that he would prepare the budget for adoption and that the Board will need to set a date to adopt the budget for fiscal year 2018-2019 before May 1st.

Trustee Murphy made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Trustee Livsey and unanimously carried.
