

RESOLUTION
Village of Highland Falls Board of Trustees
Property Maintenance
18 Wyandotte Avenue

WHEREAS, at the June 4, 2018 Village Board meeting, a public hearing was held regarding a property maintenance violation issued to the property at 18 Wyandotte Avenue at which hearing no one appeared on behalf of the property owner; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was duly closed and the Village Board took all appropriate action to remedy the violation and bill the cost of said remedy to the property owner; and

WHEREAS, thereafter, the owner of 18 Wyandotte Avenue demonstrated by competent evidence, that the wrong property had been posted and that the cost of remediation should rightly be charged to the property in violation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board rescinds the June 4, 2018 resolution finding that the owner of 18 Wyandotte Avenue failed to remedy a property maintenance violation and imposing the cost of remedy and administration on the owner of said property.
