RESOLUTION REQUESTING REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION OF THE VILLAGE OWNED WATER SUPPLY PROPERTY

WHEREAS: the Village of Highland Falls is the owner of real property in the Town of Highlands identified on the tax map as follows: and,

WHEREAS, the above real property is devoted solely to public use as part of the Village Water System as a catchment and reservoir; and

WHEREAS, the Real Property Tax Law, Section 406 (3) provides the authority for each taxing district in which municipality owned property used in such manner is located, to grant a whole exemption from real property taxes levied by the taxing district; and

WHEREAS, such exemption for the Village of Highland Falls water supply site real property would provide a direct immediate benefit for the taxpayers and water users of the Village of Highland Falls which would enhance real property ownership and exemplify a spirit of intermunicipal co-operation between the County of Orange and this Village. Now,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Trustees on behalf of the Village of Highland Falls, its taxpayers, water system users and citizens, hereby petition the County of Orange to grant a whole exemption from Orange County real property taxes commencing for the **calendar year 2021** on the parcel of real property in the Town of Highlands identified as follows:
