To Whom It May Concern,

The Village of Highland Falls is an area that has great potential to be a great economic driver in the Mid-Hudson Valley and a vibrant community for families. Located on the doorstep of West Point, Highland Falls is uniquely positioned to be able to capitalize on the hundreds of thousands of visitors to West Point, Bear Mountain State Park, and Woodbury Commons every year. It is a special area that is ripe for investment to jump to a new level for Orange County, the Hudson Valley Region, and New York State.

A major driver of Highland Falls tourism, The United States Military Academy at West Point (USMA), is unique in that it attracts many families from around our Country and the World. Cadets and professors are specially selected from across the country to attend and teach at USMA in what has become a national treasure. Highland Falls can grow and increase by providing a beautiful hometown atmosphere to pull Military Families involved with USMA off of the military installation and into the town, where their money will be spent on local businesses and not on large national chains that are exempt from taxation by location on the federal Military Reservation of West Point. An investment into Highland Falls would raise the bar and give these Military Families a reason to visit a beautiful destination rightly named "Hometown, U.S.A."

Due to its incredible location, Highland Falls can also provide a picturesque experience to two other very different types of visitors that frequent the area. The highly commercialized and very crowded Woodbury Common Premium Outlets draw one type of visitor, while Bear Mountain State Park draws a very different type of visitor. While visitors to either location would not necessarily visit the other on the same trip, they will overlap with interest in a pleasant, walkable, hometown experience. With Woodbury Commons less than 14 miles away and Bear Mountain State Park only 4 miles, Highland Falls is well-placed to draw in visitors from both locations that can increase the value of the experience of all local destinations. It creates a synergy that is exceedingly rare.

We see this grant as an investment for potential future growth and improvement. 
