

Winter is here and that means snow!

The Highland Falls Police Department is asking for everyone's cooperation when the snow falls. For the Department of Public Works to effectively clear our streets of snow or ice, no vehicles are allowed to be parked on public streets during any snow storms, regardless of the amount expected. Snow or icy streets can be dangerous. It can cause accidents and slow the response time for emergency services. Parking will be permitted after the snow or ice stops, the roads are cleared and the Department of Public Works has completed their plowing operations.

Section 187.1 A. – Unlawful to impede or interfere. It shall be unlawful for any person to push, pile or deposit snow or ice on any public road, street, sidewalk or right of way within the Village of Highland Falls.

Section 187.1 B. – It shall be unlawful for any person to interfere with, impede, obstruct, hinder, interrupt or delay any vehicle or equipment engaged or used in the operation of plowing snow or ice or of removing snow or ice from any public road, street or right-of-way or from any part thereof within the Village of Highland Falls.

Section 187.2 - Obstruction of streets or roads. It shall be unlawful for anyone to place, park or leave any vehicle on any public road, street or right of way within the Village of Highland Falls or to permit the same to remain during any snow or ice storm or precipitation or after such storm or precipitation until the snow and ice have been removed or cleared from such public street, road or right of way.

Section 187.3 - Removal of vehicles. Prohibits anyone to leave any vehicle parked or standing on any public road or street if that vehicle blocks, interferes, impedes, obstructs, hinders, interrupts or delays the operation of any plowing or snow removal operation.

Residents can sign up on the Village website, www.highlandfallsny.org, for the e-alert system to receive messages regarding snow emergencies and parking restrictions.

Please help out, do your part and follow the rules. Vehicles will be ticketed and/or towed if in violation of the above regulations. Please contact our department if you have any questions, Thank You.
