

Village of Highland Falls Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) Program

The Village of Highland Falls has formed the Village of Highland Falls Community Power renewable energy program. This community choice aggregation (CCA) program will enable Highland Falls to provide residents and small businesses with the benefits of renewable electricity supply.

Formed in partnership with Joule Community Power, a division of Joule Assets, Inc., Village of Highland Falls Community Power is a community choice aggregation (CCA) program that enables the municipality to pool local electricity demand in order to leverage the collective buying power of their residents and small businesses in an effort to secure more favorable terms on their energy supply, protect consumers, and choose renewable generation sources.

Electricity Supply Offering:

The Village of Highland Falls participated in a bid for a CCA electricity supply rate with other municipalities in Orange and Rockland utility territory. **The Village selected an electricity supplier, and we are pleased to announce that the electricity supply offering will be available as of April 1, 2023. There are two fixed-rate electricity supply options through the Village program:**

- 1) 100% Renewable Option at \$0.13068/kWh including Gross Receipts Tax
- 2) Standard Option at \$0.11410/kWh including Gross Receipts Tax

Gross Receipts Tax (or GRT) is always a part of your electricity bill in the village whether or not you participate in the CCA program.

You may choose between these supply options or opt out of the program. **The Village has chosen the 100% Renewable Option as the default.** All eligible residents and businesses will receive a letter in late winter/early spring 2023 with information about their program, their choices and info about how to opt-out. Everyone eligible will be enrolled in the 100% Renewable Option unless they choose the Standard Option or opt out of the program.

Upcoming Public Education

Public information sessions will be scheduled over the next two months. These sessions will provide general information, explain the benefits of participation by our residents and small businesses, and answer your questions.
